### AUSD, Alta Vista, and COVID-19

I am glad to share that as of today, there are no reported cases of an AVCCS or AUSD student or staff member testing positive for COVID-19. According to the CDC's "scenario" guide for schools AUSD/AVCCS currently falls under a Scenario II status: *Measures to be taken if there are two or more community transmission cases of COVID-19, but no individuals within the school test positive.* As community concerns surrounding the virus grow, and with local districts and organizations taking preventative action, we are crafting a plan to reduce the possibility of virus exposure.

Our campus houses programs serving particularly vulnerable populations. To support public wellness and slow the spread of this virus, AVCCS is adopting the following restrictions affecting school travel, public school events, clubs and non-school community events: Effective Wednesday, March 11, we are suspending after school clubs (this does not effect the ARD Discovery Club after school care program in Room 6), field trips, and assemblies through April 2. Parent-Teacher conferences this week will take place via telephone rather than in person. We are working with the various field trip vendors to see what options are available for rescheduling and will let you know as soon as we have details.

On our site, additional hand sanitizer dispensers are being installed, custodians are using enhanced cleaning practices consistent with CDC guidance, we are educating students on safe hygiene practices including shifting from hugs and hand shakes to elbow bumps. During lunchtime, the student self-serve station is being suspended.

Thank you for doing your part of ensure ongoing public health by not coming on campus within 24 hours of having a fever over 100°f, regardless of whether medication brings the fever within normal range. Our team is prepared to support any Independent Study needs students may have. We are confident and committed to maintaining a safe and healthy learning environment.
